Intent: To recognize outstanding dedication and musicianship among graduating high school students in the Stratford area, and to honour the memory of Mervyn Doerr.

Scholarship: \$1000.00

Selection: The award will be given at the discretion of the executive, and may not be awarded each year. If awarded, the recipient will be a recent high school graduate who has shown personal commitment to instrumental music and dedication to wind ensemble music in the Stratford area.

Criteria: The recipient will be commencing post-secondary education in the coming year at a recognized university, college or technical institute.

Procedure: The Stratford Concert Band Executive will determine the winner (or winners) of the scholarship.

Presentation: The scholarship will be presented by the Stratford Concert Band executive. Monies will be awarded upon presentation of proof of enrolment. The scholarship must be used within two years. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, if a student is unable to complete high school and move on to post secondary, they will be required to return the scholarship money back to the band. The student may also reject the scholarship and reapply next year.
